**FACTS.com** provides the complete content from the **Facts On File World News Digest** since 1940 and a live newsfeed from Reuters® to answer questions about events, people, and major issues of the last 60+ years.

*Facts On File World News Digest* distills news from more than 100 major newspapers, news magazines, other periodicals, and government and on-line sources from the U.S. and around the world into a permanent record. The editors seek to record all those events that might be of lasting significance, and to anticipate the needs of researchers in the future. The emphasis throughout is on facts rather than opinion or analysis. *Facts On File World News Digest* articles qualify as “primary source material” for student research papers.

*FACTS.com* also delivers hundreds of full-text editorials with a political and geographic balance of opinion on key events of the last 25 years. Clicking "Newspaper Editorials" accesses a master list of editorial topics.

Facts.com can help you find out what happened on a certain date in the news, or zero in on the top news stories of a decade.

Facts.com also offers maps, photographs, historic documents, obituaries of famous people, country profiles, and special overviews of major issues.

### ***To connect to Facts.com:***

1. On the World Wide Web, go to <http://www.knoxcounty.org/library>
2. Click on the words “Reference Databases”
3. Follow the links and instructions to access Facts.com using your library card number

### ***Facts.com tips:***

1. Enter any word or combination of words in the Search Box. If you enter more than one search term, the search will find articles that contain all of the terms you entered. Capitalization does not matter.
2. Use double quotation marks to search an exact phrase: type "**white house**" and **taliban** for articles with white house as a phrase that also contain taliban
3. Use the \* symbol to stand in for the rest of a word that could have various endings: **produc\*** will search for items containing *produce*, *product*, *production*, etc.
4. Check "Title Field Search Only" to limit your search to words found in article titles.
5. Change the sort order by selecting "Story Date" or "Relevance Rank." "Story Date" puts the most recent articles first. Undated special features go to the bottom.
6. Check/uncheck "Other Available Databases" to expand or limit your search.
7. Limit searches by date by picking "From" and "To" dates.
8. The Results List shows the number of articles in the selected Sources that contain all the terms entered, and up to the first 25 of those articles. Click on any article title on the list to go to the article. If more than 25 articles contain the search terms, the bottom of the Results List will link to further pages of results.
9. Use the “Print/Citation” button at the top of an article display to get a printable view and help citing the article in a bibliography.
