

## **Terminal Server Implementation**

### **Install Terminal Server on a computer running Windows Server 2003:**

1. Click “Start”, click “Control Panel”, and then double-click “Add or Remove Programs”.
2. Click “Add/Remove Windows Components”.
3. In the dialog box, select “Terminal Server”.
4. Follow the instructions in the Windows Components Wizard.

### **To install Terminal Server Licensing:**

1. Click “Start”, click “Control Panel”, and the double-click “Add or Remove Programs”.
2. Click “Add/Remove Windows Components”.
3. In the dialog box, select “Terminal Server Licensing”.
4. Follow the instructions in the Windows Components Wizard.

### **To activate Terminal Server Licensing:**

1. On the computer running TSL Server, click Start, Programs, Administrative Tools, and Terminal Server Licensing.
2. If the License Server has not been activated, in the console tree, right-click the Terminal Server License Server you want to activate.
3. Click “Activate Server” to start the Activation Wizard.
4. In the Activation method list, select Automatic connection (recommended), and then click Next.
5. Follow the instructions in the wizard.

### **To install CALs for licensing:**

1. On the computer running Terminal Server Licensing, click “Start, Programs, Administrative Tools, and Terminal Server Licensing”.
2. Select the license server in the right pane, and then on the Action menu, Install, Licenses.
3. Follow the steps in the wizard for a successful installation of the CALs.
